<u>Aftercare times</u>	Grades R and RR	12h30 – onwards
	Grades 1 and 2	13h00 – onwards
	Grade 3	After sport – onwards OR from 14h00 on those days when sport is cancelled ONLY

Please note that:

- Where aftercare is utilized **after** 14h30 this is counted as a full afternoon and will be charged accordingly.
- Should a boy be collected **before** 14h30 this will be counted as a half afternoon and will be charged accordingly.
- Grade 3 boys attending aftercare after sport will be charged at a reduced rate of R450 per term or R15 per afternoon irrespective of the time of arrival or departure.

Aftercare closes promptly at 17h00. Late collections will attract a R100 penalty per 15 minutes after 17h00.

Aftercare will be available on the Thursday of the mid-term and on break-up day at the end of the term but NOT on a Public Holiday.

Lunch and Snack

A cooked lunch is provided on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.
A picnic lunch is given on Tuesday and Thursday.
A snack (usually sandwiches, fruit and juice) is provided at 15h00.

Uniform

Grade R, RR and RRR boys need an additional set of clothes and a plastic packet for dirty clothes. (This is over and above their extra set of clothes for their school day.)

The school fleece is advisable for boys who stay later into the afternoon when the weather can become cool.

- **Inky boys must wear blue boxer shorts and their coloured Inky shirt.**
- **The Grade 1, 2 and 3 boys may wear blue boxer shorts and a plain blue, green or red T shirt. Each boy needs a school fleece for cold days.**
- **Boys may not go home in swimming clothes. They must change into Khakis or Blues and Whites. Boys may not leave Cordwalles without shoes when wearing Khakis or sport kit.**

Aftercare Homework Policy

1. Homework will be supervised between 14h30 and 15h00.
2. Only boys who conscientiously commit themselves to doing their homework will be allowed into the homework room.
3. Only the written components of literacy homework will be supervised.
4. Checking of homework, reading of correspondence and signing of the homework book is the parent's responsibility. Computer-related homework, reading and any homework, such as flashcards, not completed in the allocated half hour at aftercare, must please be finished at home under parental supervision. Communication between the teacher and the parent is essential. This is done via the homework book.

PLEASE REMEMBER : Boys must be signed out every day!!

Aftercare staff need to be notified of a change of routine in collection arrangements i.e. if a different person is collecting your son he will NOT be permitted to leave where a person is unknown to the aftercare staff unless they have been informed in advance.
